Notice of Intent

To Pump Sewage from a Local Sewer to a District Sewer

1. Applicability

Any municipality planning to pump sewage from a local sewer to a District sewer during local sewer construction must submit a *Notice of Intent*. If plans change after approval, then the municipality must notify the District of the change and obtain re-approval.

2. Timing

The District must receive the *Notice of Intent* at least ten (10) working days before pumping is anticipated to begin. An on-site meeting with District staff, municipality staff, and appropriate contracted staff will be required to verify the point of discharge.

If the discharge will require the District to reroute flows within the Metropolitan Interceptor Sewer (MIS) system or direct flow to the Inline Storage System (ISS), (or if the initial NOI is such that it is determined that flows need to be rerouted), the District must receive the diversion plan *at least (30)* working days before pumping is anticipated to begin. A meeting between with District, Veolia Water Milwaukee, municipality, and contractor staff will be required to approve the diversion plan. An on-site meeting with District staff, municipal staff, and appropriate contracted staff will also be required to verify the point of discharge.

The municipality may commence pumping only after receiving written approval from the District.

4. Contact Person

The *Notice of Intent* must identify a contact person who is a municipal employee with responsibility for managing the pumping. The contact person is not necessarily the same person who must sign this *Notice of Intent*.

5. The District's Response

The District will respond to *Notices of Intent* with either a letter of approval, a letter of disapproval, a request for additional information or a meeting request.

You may commence pumping only after receiving an approval letter.
